## AGENDA

Welcome and Introductions – President Suzanne Scheidt welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm. Everyone introduced themselves.

Agenda Additions or Revisions – No changes.

Approval of Meeting Minutes – President Scheidt called for additions or corrections to the April 9, 2024, meeting minutes. Todd Henry moved to approve the minutes as submitted. Doug Greenlund seconded the motion. President Scheidt called for discussion and the vote, and the motion passed unanimously.

Financial Report – Treasurer Ron Wilson provided the May financials which included check #3856 for \$2,000 to Phase 3 Digital.

IWAC's bank balance as of 3/31/24 was \$38,821.42

## **Old Business**

Discussion - Grant opportunities for funding the updated aquifer model. President Scheidt reported that the Kootenai County Aquifer Protection District recommended a \$30,000 grant approved by the Kootenai Board of County Commissioners to support Phase 1 of the project. IWAC is also planning to apply for an IDEQ Source Water Protection Grant.

Aquifer Model Update Presentations – Dan Kegley reported that John Porcello, Amy Sumner, and Seth Oliver have agreed to speak at future presentation sessions being scheduled for operators and stakeholders. Dan is currently working on the presentation outline.

#### **New Business**

**Aquifer Model Update - Draft Request for Proposals** (RFP) President Scheidt presented data gathered to date pertaining to the development of an RFP for phase 1. IWAC members agreed to narrow the scope of the update to reflect purveyor wells drawing from the RPA portion of the SVRPA as SAJB was completing a similar update of Spokane County purveyor wells. President Scheidt reported that SAJB is willing to share the final Model-USG produced for this effort with IWAC. President Scheidt presented the SAJB project scope and asked IWAC members to review and be prepared to discuss at the June 11<sup>th</sup> meeting. President Scheidt also presented a letter received by Michelle Richman, IDWR regarding the model update.

**IWAC Administrative Assistant Position** – Succession Planning and Job Description – Tonilee Hanson is retiring on 12/15/24. IWAC Members began initial planning discussion for a successor to this position. It was decided the topic be included under Old Business at the June 11<sup>th</sup> meeting.

**Updates Around the Table** – Both Dan Kegley and Rob Lindsay plan to retire in 2024. Their support and guidance over the years have been vital to IWAC's success and we hope they stay involved as much as possible.

Adjourn - There being no further business on this 14<sup>th</sup> day of May 2024, the meeting was adjourned at 3:00 pm.
